

SALVATION IS BY GRACE THROUGH FAITH EVEN IN THE OT



- 1) Salvation was by grace through faith for Abraham vv. 1-2
- 2) Salvation was by grace through faith for David vv. 3-5
- 3) Only salvation by grace through faith brings peace and blessing from God. vv.6-7

- 1. What then shall we say that Abraham, our forefather according to the flesh, has found?
- 2. For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God.
- 3. For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS."



- 4. Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due.
- 5. But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness,
- 6. just as David also speaks of the blessing on the man to whom God credits righteousness apart from works:
- 7. "BLESSED ARE THOSE WHOSE LAWLESS DEEDS HAVE BEEN FORGIVEN, AND WHOSE SINS HAVE BEEN COVERED.
- 8. "BLESSED IS THE MAN WHOSE SIN THE LORD WILL NOT TAKE INTO ACCOUNT."

EARLY JEWISH THOUGHT ON ABRAHAM

The Book of Jubilees (200bc), "Abraham was perfect in all his deeds with the Lord, and well pleasing in righteousness all the days of his life."



<u>Prayer of Manasseh</u> (100-200 bc) "Therefore though, O Lord, God of the righteous, has not appointed repentance for the righteous; for Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, who did not sin against You, but You has appointed repentance for me, who am a sinner."

<u>Ecclesiasticus</u> (also known as The Wisdom of Sirach) Abraham is said to have become right with God because of His faithfulness in keeping "The Law of the Most High." (44:19-21).

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FAITH IS NOT A "WORK"

<u>Ephesians 2:8-9</u> tells us. "For by <u>grace</u> you have been saved through <u>faith</u>; and <u>that</u> not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of <u>works</u>, so that no one may boast."



- <u>Faith</u> in and of itself is <u>worthless</u>, it is the <u>OBJECT</u> of our faith that is everything.
- Your faith is <u>only as good</u> as the <u>object you put it in</u>.
- It was <u>not</u> the <u>greatness of Abrahams faith</u> that saved him. It was the <u>greatness of the One</u> he <u>put his faith</u> IN that mattered!"

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ROMANS 4:3

3. For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS."
