2. Neglected. (Gal. 3:3-6; 5:17)

3. Stifled (suppressed or 'quenched') (1 Thess. 5:19)

4. Tested. (Acts 5:9).

THE THIRD PERSON OF THE TRINITY

He IS God.

1) He is Eternal (Heb 9:14)

2) Has glory (1 Peter 4:14; cf. Is. 42:8; 48:11)

3) Is <u>Holy</u> (Ps 51:11; Is. 63:10-11; Mat 1:18; Rom 1:4)

4) Omnipotent (Gen 1:1-2; Luke 1:35; Rom 1:4)

5) Omnipresent (Ps 139:7-10; cf Jer. 23:24)

6) Omniscient (Is. 40:13; 1 Cor. 2:10-11)

7) Called God (Acts 5:3-4)

- 1. Should add an element of seriousness and weight to your prayers.
- 2. Tells us just how important prayer is.
- 3. Helps us see the Power of prayer.
- 4. Lets us know that our prayers are important to God and that He is even helping us with them to bring about His perfect will by them.
- 5. Knowing this, why WOULDN'T we pray?

1 COR. 2:9-13

"As it is written, "THINGS WHICH EYE HAS NOT SEEN AND EARL HAS NOT HEARD, AND which HAVE NOT ENTERED THE HEART OF MAN, ALL THAT GOD HAS PREPARED FOR THOSE WHO LOVE HIM."

For to us God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God. For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so the thoughts of God no one knows except the Spirit of God. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God, which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words."
