
JOSHUA 1:1-9

"Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed..."

"Now the Lord said to Abram, Go forth from your country, And from your relatives, And from your father's house, To the **land** which I will show you; And I will make you a **great nation**, And I will bless you, And make your name great; And so you shall be a blessing; And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be bless." So Abram went forth as the LORD had spoken to him...Abram took Sarai his wife and Lot his nephew and all their possessions which they had accumulated...and they set out for the land of **Canaan**.

Abram passed through the land as far as the site of Shechem to the oak of Moreh. Now the Canaanite was then in the land. The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your descendants I will give this land."

- ✓ God <u>remains faithful</u> to His <u>people</u>—despite the difficult circumstances.
- ✓ God is <u>trustworthy</u>.
- ✓ Don't wilt, don't cower, be strong and courageous!
- ✓ "Courage is not the absence of fear. Courage is, very simply, the presence of faith" Lt. Cmdr. McDaniel
- ✓ God <u>keeps His Word</u>, His promises <u>transcend the rise and fall of people and nations</u>.

8. This **book** of the law <u>shall not depart</u> from your <u>mouth</u>, but you <u>shall</u> meditate on it day and night, <u>so that</u> you may be careful to <u>do</u> according to all that is written in it; for <u>then</u> you will make your way <u>prosperous</u>, and then you will have <u>success</u>.

- ✓ Exodus 17:14 "Then the LORD said to Moses, "Write this in a book as a memorial and recite it to Joshua"
- ✓ Exodus 34:1 "The LORD said to Moses, "Cut out for yourself two stone tablets like the former ones, and I will write on the tablets the words that were on the former tablets..."
- ✓ Exodus 34:27 "Then the LORD said to Moses, "Write down these words..."
- ✓ Joshua 24:26 "And Joshua wrote these words in the book of the Law of God."
- ✓ 1 Samuel 10:25 "Then Samuel...wrote them in the book and placed it before the LORD."
- ✓ <u>Jeremiah 36:18</u> "The Baruch said to them, "He [God] dictates all these words to me, and I wrote them with ink on the book."
