

MATTHEW 15:29-31

29 Departing from there, Jesus went along by the Sea of Galilee, and having gone up on the mountain, he was sitting there.

“Wonderful Counselor”

- The word means “Wonder.”
- He is the “wonder counselor” or “the One who counsels with wonder.”
- The same word is used to describe the miracles that God did in Egypt.
- In Him is hidden all the treasure of wisdom and knowledge

“Mighty God”

- Pretty self explanator!
