

ROMANS 11:25-27

25 For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery—so that you will not be wise in your own estimation—that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in;



26 and so all Israel will be saved; just as it is written, "THE DELIVERER WILL COME FROM ZION, HE WILL REMOVE UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB."

"For you are a holy people to the LORD your God; the LORD your <u>God has chosen you</u> to be a people for <u>His own possession</u> out of all the peoples who are on the <u>face of the earth</u>. "The LORD did <u>not</u> set His love on you nor choose you because you were <u>more in number</u> than any of the peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples, but because the <u>LORD loved you</u> and <u>kept the oath which He swore</u> to your forefathers"

THE CYCLE OF ISRAEL

- 1. Israel sins against God.
- 2. God warns them to repent.
- 3. They don't listen.
- 4. God punishes them.
- 5. They cry out to God.
- 6. God delivers them.
- 7. Repeat.



ROMANS 11:25

25<u>a</u> For I do not want you, brethren, to be <u>uninformed</u> of this <u>mystery</u>—so that you will not be <u>wise in your own</u> estimation—

25b that a <u>partial</u> hardening has happened to Israel <u>until</u> the <u>fullness of the</u> <u>Gentiles</u> has come in;

- ✓ "Until"—Something is going to continue up to a point in time—then it will end.
- ✓ "Fullness"—Fill, completion, fulfillment.

Luke 21:24 "and they will fall by the edge of the sword, and will be led captive into all the nations; and Jerusalem will be trampled under foot by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled."

John 10:16 ""I have other sheep, which are not of this fold; I must bring them also, and they will hear My voice; and they will become one flock with one shepherd."



Acts 15:14-19 "Simeon [Peter] has related how God first concerned Himself about taking from among the Gentiles a people for His name. "With this the words of the Prophets agree, just as it is written, 'AFTER THESE THINGS I will return, AND I WILL REBUILD THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID WHICH HAS FALLEN, AND I WILL REBUILD ITS RUINS, AND I WILL RESTORE IT, SO THAT THE REST OF MANKIND MAY SEEK THE LORD, AND ALL THE GENTILES WHO ARE CALLED BY MY NAME,' SAYS THE LORD, WHO MAKES THESE THINGS KNOWN FROM LONG AGO. "Therefore it is my judgment that we do not trouble those who are turning to God from among the Gentiles.

- 1) Is it—All believers; Jew and Gentile?
- 2) Is it—Christian Jews? (Remnant)
- 3) Is it—Ethnic Israel—the Nation?

✓ "Israel" is used <u>10X</u> in Chapters 9-11 and in <u>EVERY instance</u> it means Ethnic Israel.
