ROMANS 16:17-20

17 Now I urge you, brethren, keep your eye on those who cause dissensions and hindrances contrary to the teaching which you learned, and turn away from them.

18 For such men are slaves, not of our Lord Christ but of their own appetites; and by their smooth and flattering speech they deceive the hearts of the unsuspecting.

19 For the report of your obedience has reached to all; therefore I am rejoicing over you, but I want you to be wise in what is good and innocent in what is evil.



"PEACE"



- From verbal form meaning "To bind together that which was separated."
- It is a **CONDITION** (not so much a feeling).
- You, as a Christian, are <u>AT peace</u> WITH God.

"Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice!

Let your gentle spirit be known to all men. The Lord is near. <u>Be anxious for nothing</u>, but in everything by <u>prayer</u> and <u>supplication</u> with <u>thanksgiving</u> let your requests <u>be made known</u> to God. And <u>the peace</u> <u>of God</u>, which surpasses all comprehension, will <u>guard</u> your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
